

# TRIP CHECKLIST

## OUR PACKING GUIDE

### Essential Clothing:

- Light layers for versatile weather conditions
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Casual, outfits for driving days
- Dress outfit for dining out or evening events
- Warm layer for cool or windy evenings Swimsuit

### Accessories:

- Sunglasses
- Reading glasses (if needed)
- Day pack for overnight desert stay

### Electronics:

- Camera
- Laptop or iPad
- Universal plug adapter
- Chargers for all devices

### Personal Care:

- Sunscreen (high SPF recommended)
- Travel-sized toiletries

### Optional Items:

- Small Reading light (rooms may be dimly lit)
- Travel pillow-hotel/riad pillows can be large and hard
- Laundry detergent sheets if you plan to hand wash
- Sun hat for protection
- Steri-Pen UV water purifier (to avoid plastic water bottles)
- Corkscrew (if planning to buy wine locally)
- Your favorite bottle of liquor (as options may be limited)

### Additional Tips:

- Consider packing light, breathable fabrics suitable for Morocco's climate
- Don't forget any necessary medications and a basic first-aid kit
- Luggage with 4 wheels have superior maneuverability for easier pushing and pulling
- Pepto bismol/ charcoal- this will coat your stomach and prevent upset

### Additional items for extended Travel:

- Collapsible washing bin
- Retractable travel clothesline
- Water activated face wash cloths or washcloth (they are unavailable in hotel/riads)
- Extension cord
